

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at:

- Counting sets of objects carefully and finding the matching numbers.
- Ordering numbers.
- Looking at adding and subtracting practically using objects.
- Using the part-part whole model to add and combine.
- Finding one more and one less than a number.



PSED

The children will be looking at different families and talking about how we are the same and different from each other. We will be sharing and turn taking whilst accessing the classroom resources. Looking at feelings and emotions linked to characters in stories we read.



Phonics

In phonics we will be looking at:

- Being able to read all the taught sounds so far. s,a,t,p,l,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,e,u,r,h,b,f,ff,l,ll,ss
- Reading and building CVC words.
- Learning the tricky words: I to no the go into
- Reading some of the phase 3 sounds (a new bookmark will be sent home when we have learned the first few of these)
- Segmenting and blending to spell and read.



Literacy

In Literacy we will be looking at

- Talking about and describing bonfire night and fireworks.
- Reading and learning the story of 'The Owl Babies' and enjoying acting out the story.
- Learning the Christmas Story.
- Writing simple words and captions.
- Practising letter formation and writing our names without using our name cards.
